

Gentle Steps™ Programming / Adjustment

Step 1 – Press and hold the center button until the display flashes and reads “98” then release the button.

(The Transmitter is now in Programming Mode)

Step 2 – With the display flashing the number “98”, place the receiver to within 2 – 6 inches of the transmitter. When the receiver is in place the low battery light will activate.

Step 3 – While the receiver’s low battery light activated use the up or down buttons to advance or decrease the setting. The receiver will beep twice and the low battery light will blink a specific number of times to correspond to the selected setting. If this is the setting you desire then press the center button to set the level.

(For example if training level 5 is selected the receiver will blink 5 times)

Note: You can only advance or decrease the setting one level at a time. After making an adjustment the display will stop blinking for 2 seconds and then begin to blink again. Once the display begins to blink another adjustment can be made.

Training Guide

Please read and follow guide as outlined

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- Your training will consist of **14 Days** (Two full weeks)
- First week is **Leash Training ONLY!** Your pet must be **on a leash at ALL times for the first 7 Days.**
- First day of training will be done by a Representative of Unseen Fencing. ***The 1st day is the Most Important Day of your training!***
- The first day will consist of you, the homeowner, working with the representative of Unseen Fencing. Your pet will be led to 4-5 different places at the flag line (using a short leash) and told with a firm voice, **“BAD FLAG”**; your pet will then be allowed to hear the **“WARNING BEEP”**, immediately then your pet should be pulled back from the Flag line and praised, **“GOOD DOG.”** (Go overboard with the praise). **You want your pet to avoid the flags.** You then will allow your pet a few warning beeps, allow your pet to receive a mild correction. **WARNING: the collar will increase the correction automatically if your pet stays in the correction field.** Make sure to pull your pet from the field as soon as they feel the correction.
- The following six (6) days, repeat these steps, going 5-6 places around the yard and always coming away from the flag line and praise.
- On 7th day: Use a long leash to see if your pet will go past the Flag Line.

- Allow your pet to go free (**dragging the leash**) for the first **4 Days.** ***Do Not Leave Your Pet Unattended.***
- The last **3 Days** of week two, you (the homeowner) needs to go past the **“flag line”**, if your pet comes to you, then you will need to shake the flag and say, **“NO BAD FLAG!”**
- The 15th day is the **“WALK OF TRUTH”** day. Leave the yard, making sure that your pet sees you leave. This is to see if your pet will follow. If your pet DOES NOT follow you, then you may begin (after 3 weeks) removing every other flag every other day until they are all gone.

IMPORTANT KEY POINTS:

- **Never call your pet to come outside the fence line**
- **The contact posts must always stay in contact with your pet's skin**
- **We suggest taking several short trips (20-30 minutes) before leaving on longer trips**
